Instructions for First Visit

- Please bring all x-rays, this referral slip, pertinent medical information and a list of ALL medications you are currently taking.
- Please alert the office if you have a medical condition that may be of concern prior to surgery.
- Please bring both your medical and dental insurance information on the day of your appointment.
- Patients under eighteen (18) years of age must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

Instructions for General Anesthesia

PLEASE NOTE: In most instances the patient is seen first for consultation to review the health history, decide on the most appropriate anesthesia and treatment plan, and schedule the surgery at a separate appointment.

- Patients receiving general anesthesia must have NO FOOD OR DRINK, including water, at least 8 hours prior to surgery.
- A responsible person must accompany you and remain in our office during your treatment. They must also be able to drive you home. Do not plan to drive an automobile the day of the procedure.

Please give 48 hours notice if you are unable to keep this appointment.
